During the primaries, Trump said that he wants to deport all undocumented people from this country.

How can I protect myself and my family from deportation?



## I don't have DACA

DON'T apply for DACA. The application asks for your address. Trump could use this information to send ICE to your home. You should wait to apply so that we can see if Trump will use this information to deport people.

### Have a Plan

Plan who is going to take care of your family if you are arrested by immigration. Store your immigration papers and give someone a copy. Get a lawyer's contact info. Memorize the phone number of a family member and this number that can connect you to an attorney if you are arrested:

**855-HELP-MY-FAMILY**

## I have DACA

If you put your current address on your DACA application, DON'T panic. It is unclear whether Trump will send immigration to your home. To be completely safe, prepare now. Save money to move if it becomes necessary. If you can't afford to move, make plans to stay with family or friends. The important thing is that you are able to move if at some point you feel that you are in danger of being deported. If you want to renew your DACA, all DACA renewals should be submitted before 11/18/2016.
